

Important Requirement Update: Installer Certification Required as of September 1, 2021

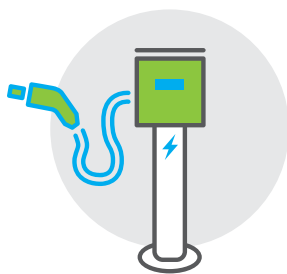


Applicants who do not comply will not be eligible for rebates.

STEP 1

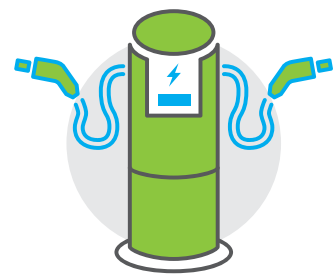
Review updated incentive project requirements.

Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program (EVITP) requirements are located in the individual project implementation manuals. The requirements apply to applicants who receive notification of funds reserved status on or after September 1, 2021 for the following incentive projects: San Diego County, Peninsula-Silicon Valley, Inland Counties, South Central Coast, and all future projects.



UNDER 25kW
1 EVITP per crew

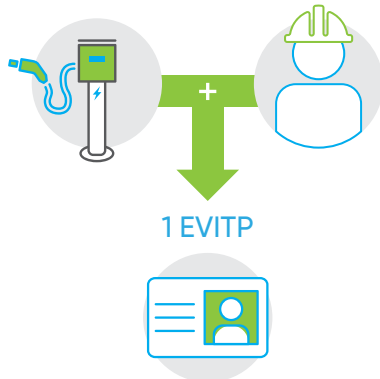
Electric vehicle charging infrastructure and equipment must be installed by a contractor with the appropriate license classification, and at least one electrician on each crew, at any given time, who holds EVITP certification.



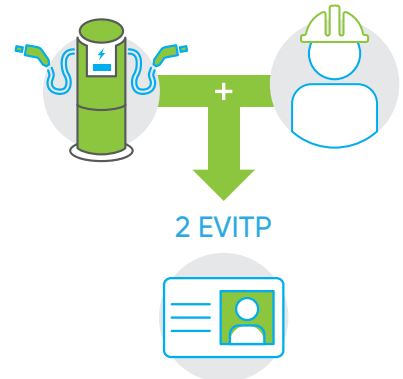
25kW+
25% EVITP per crew

If the equipment supports a charging port supplying 25 kilowatts or more, at least 25% of the total electricians working on the crew, at any given time, must hold EVITP certification.

Ex) Under 25kW 8 Electricians



Ex) 25kW+ 8 Electricians



STEP 2

Find an installer that uses EVITP-certified electricians.

Use the contractor list at EVITP.org and provide the CALeVIP Job Site Installation Form for your selected installer to review. You can require the Job Site Installation Form be filled out in your installer contract.



STEP 3

Submit Job Site Installation Form when payment is requested.

Submit a completed Job Site Installation Form at the first milestone payment (if applicable) and final payment.
