



FAQ for Fast Charge for All Incentive (Sonoma Coast Incentive Project)

Q: Who will provide the incentive?

A: The additional incentive will be administered and delivered through CSE, with funding from Sonoma Clean power (SCP).

Q: How many chargers are eligible?

A: This additional incentive funding is for up to 2 Direct Current Fast Chargers (DCFC)chargers from your original applications (at the same incentive amounts).

Q: Am I still eligible for other chargers, such as L2 or more than 2 DCFC?

A: This incentive is only for up to 2 DCFCs from your original application (additional DCFC or L2 ports in your wait-listed application would not be funded from this additional incentive and would be processed in the order received if additional funding becomes available).

Q: What if I am not an SCP EverGreen customer now?

A: If you are an SCP customer, you can upgrade to SCP's EverGreen service that delivers 100% local renewable electricity 24/7 by going to: <https://sonomacleanpower.org/cleanstart-evergreen>

If you are not an SCP customer and you decided to opt out before service began, or within the first 60 days, you can return to Sonoma Clean Power at any time.

Customers who opt out 60 days after SCP service starts are subject to PG&E's terms and conditions, which stipulate that they cannot return to SCP service for one year.

Successful applicants must be subscribed to EverGreen service prior to the first milestone payment being issued.

Q: How do I know where I am on the waitlist?

A: Please email CSE at sonoma-coast-calevip@energycenter.org or call (707) 509-3400 to check your place on the waitlist, cancel your application, or ask other questions.

Q: Can I change my application?

A: You may change your application, but only to remove chargers at the original location, in accordance with CALeVIP terms and conditions.



DRAFT FAST CHARGE FOR ALL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

This Program Participation Agreement (“Agreement”), dated as of _____ (“Effective Date”) is by and between the Sonoma Clean Power Authority, a California joint powers authority (“SCPA”), and _____ (“Customer”).

SCPA’s Fast Charge for All Program offers a special incentive for Customers on the California Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Project “CALeVIP” wait list to fund new Direct Current Fast Charge stations in targeted locations by matching the CALeVIP incentive amount. SCPA is able to provide this program by monetizing future Low Carbon Fuel Standard “LCFS” credits earned on behalf of participating Customers utilizing incentivized electrical vehicle service equipment (“EVSE”).

To participate in SCPA’s Fast Charge for All Program, Customer certifies that:

- ❑ Customer is an eligible recipient of project funds through the Sonoma Coast Incentive Project;¹
- ❑ Customer agrees to the project terms and conditions, eligibility requirements, and the approved funding amount established through the Sonoma Coast Incentive Project;
- ❑ Customer agrees that Fast Charge for All program charging equipment will connect solely to an electrical service account that subscribes to SCPA’s EverGreen service;
- ❑ Customer agrees to provide direct access to session/usage data from its network provider/operator beyond the 5 years required for the Sonoma Coast Incentive Project;
- ❑ Customer agrees to share information on Fast Charge for All Program related revenue, electricity costs, maintenance costs, and land rental costs with SCPA for state reporting purposes;
- ❑ Customer acknowledges that all LCFS credits earned from the enrolled chargers will be used by SCPA to support transportation electrification; and
- ❑ Customer shall pay prevailing wages for the installation to the extent applicable and otherwise comply with Labor Code section 1720 et seq. and applicable law. Customer shall defend, indemnify, and hold SCPA harmless from its failure to do so.

This incentive is available only for Fast Charge for All participants and only for sites which meet the criteria established by SCPA and selected for funding based on the order of valid applications received.

Fast Charge for All Project and Program Criteria:

- The project must be established by a current SCPA Customer connected solely to an electrical service account that subscribes to SCPA’s EverGreen service.

- The project must be located near a major highway as determined by SCPA, and must not be located within 5 miles from an existing Direct Current Fast Charging station; OR the project must be located within 2 miles of multi-family housing where residents are receiving United States Department of Housing and Urban Development program assistance.
- Located in Mendocino or Sonoma counties
- Sites with a mail address in the cities/towns of Healdsburg, Laytonville, Leggett, Ukiah and Willits are not eligible for DCFC funds.
- Chargers are publicly available 24 hours per day, 365 days a year.
- Charger(s) must not be located behind a fence or in a gated parking lot closed to the public after hours.
- Premises must be well-lit, secure, and in compliance with all federal, state and municipal laws, ordinances, rules, codes, standards and regulations.
- Be an eligible site: airport, city/county/private-owned parking lot or garage, college/university, gas station, grocery store, hospital, library, public transit hub, restaurant, retail shopping center, urban/suburban retail core, or curbside charging.

By signing below, Customer represents and warrants that they have the requisite legal authority and/or express written permission to enter into this Agreement, and to perform the obligations required by this Agreement.

DRAFT FAST CHARGE FOR ALL LCFS CREDIT DESIGNATION AGREEMENT

This Low Carbon Fuel Standard (“LCFS”) Credit Designation Agreement (“Agreement”), dated as of _____ (“Effective Date”) is by and between the Sonoma Clean Power Authority, a California joint powers authority (“SCPA”), and _____ (“Customer”), for the purpose of designating all LCFS credits accrued by the Fast Charge for All funded Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (“EVSE”) located at _____ (“Project Site”) to SCPA.

Projects which participate to SCPA’s Fast Charge for All Program (“Program”) must delegate all claims to any Low Carbon Fuel Standard (“LCFS”) credits that will be associated with the Fast Charge for All funded EVSE to SCPA. As the designated entity, SCPA will accept all LCFS responsibilities as the fuel reporting entity and credit generator pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 95483(c)(2)(B). LCFS credits monetized by SCPA will support electric vehicle infrastructure, low carbon electricity, customer education, and community program development pursuant to California Air Resource Board (“CARB”) LCFS Guidance 20-03.

Pursuant to CARB requirements governing LCFS credits, the Customer may designate another entity to be the LCFS credit generator through a written contract. This LCFS Credit Designation Agreement shall serve as the formal declaration and designation of the LCFS credits to SCPA generated by EVSE installed at the project site address listed above.

The undersigned Customer hereby represents and warrants to SCPA that it is the vested owner of the EVSE station(s) installed at the project site address listed above. Customer represents and warrants that it has the requisite legal authority and/or express written permission to enter into this LCFS Credit Designation Agreement, and to perform the obligations required by this LCFS Credit Designation Agreement.

Upon delegation of LCFS credits to SCPA, EVSE Owner agrees that (1) it will not claim generated LCFS credits; (2) will inform third-party entities, when necessary, that the LCFS credits generated by their installed EVSE are delegated to SCPA; and (3) will provide SCPA, or provide SCPA access to, the EVSE usage and electricity data for LCFS reporting, data management, recordkeeping, and auditing pursuant to California Code of Regulations sections 95483.2(b)(8) and 95491.1 and related regulatory standards and guidance set by CARB.
