Differences Between FCCP Windows

Did you participate in the **Fast Charge California Project Window 1** (FCCP-1)? Are you curious how the two new Fast Charge California Project (FCCP) application windows compare? Read on to understand the differences between each of the Fast Charge California Project windows.

The **FCCP-2** and **FCCP-3** are the latest incentive projects announced under the CALeVIP 2.0 block grant and has many similarities with the FCCP-1. However, there are several differences summarized in the table below. For more in-depth information, review the project Implementation Manuals that will be available in the CALeVIP Document Library.
